

Improving Tax Collection & Reducing Leakages

(Collective Inputs from over 200,000 Citizens on LocalCircles)

- 1. The department should create a special team to crackdown on banquets who ask for cash payment to evade taxes. Ones caught banquets should be heavily penalised
- 2. Presenting the rent agreement should be made mandatory along with the rent receipts
- 3. The licences of the manufacturers providing false information to evade excise should be cancelled
- 4. Charging but not reporting VAT and service tax should be made a criminal offence
- 5. The income tax inspectors should be given refresher courses and should be trained on latest techniques of catching tax evasion
- 6. More benefits should be provided on making online/credit card/debit card payments so that the money could be easily reported
- 7. No cash transactions should be allowed for an amount in excess of Rs. 10,000
- 8. Simplification of tax rules and making them easily understandable to a layman is required so it can be followed by more citizens and businesses
- 9. Payment of taxes must be made people friendly and rewarding
- 10. The charges like 1.8 to 2 percent on purchases on credit card in institutions like IRCTC and petrol pumps etc. must be eliminated so that more people are encouraged to use them
- 11. Every establishment should be compelled to do all its transactions electronically
- 12. E payment facilities like card swipe machines and online fund transfer should be available with each business establishment however small it may be
- 13. All payments by wholesalers/retailers should mandatorily be done through cheque or net banking or credit card only
- 14. Use of ATM, Credit Cards should be encouraged by waiving of service tax and charges
- 15. COD e-Commerce transactions of all citizens should also be scrutinized.
